## SQUARED AWAY - Rainbow Sconce



Materials needed:
4 pieces $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inch square OGT 151 Red glass 4 pieces $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inch square OGT 171 Orange glass 4 pieces $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inch square OGT 161 Yellow glass 4 pieces $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inch square OGT 123 Medium Green glass
4 pieces $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inch square WIS 96-16 Sapphire Blue glass
4 pieces $1 \frac{1}{2}$ inch square OGT 146 Dark Purple 38 pieces $1 / 2$ inch square OGT 200 White Opal glass.

Rainbows are always pretty. I thought it would be fun to make a square away rainbow sconce.

Set out the first row with one of each of the 6 colored squares with about $1 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ space between each square. I building the project on a kiln shelf on my work table. When it's finished, l'll carry the shelf to the kiln but, if you prefer, you could build your project inside the kiln.

## Squared Away Rainbow Sconce



With the 4 rows of each of the different colors set out, use a straight edge to line them up.


Start placing the small $1 / 2$ inch white squares at the middle of each square to act as bridges to connect all the colored squares.


## Squared Away Rainbow Sconce

I put them on a little sloppy here. No worries. I'll straighten everything out when it's in the kiln.


Fix the position of all the squares before firing. Here l'm using a dental pick. I like these for moving glass around on a kiln shelf.
