

Is a generator affected by elevation?

Yes, elevation can slightly reduce the generator's performance, but for most applications it won't be enough to be a serious deficiency, and not so much that going one step up to the next size machine won't comfortably allow for the difference. It's unlikely a generator will perform adequately at Everest base camp, but even in the Colorado or Wyoming mountains one can produce enough oxygen for most torch work.

Is a generator affected by humidity?

They won't work underwater, but many people in places like Florida and Mississippi are using them without problems. There shouldn't be any problem unless the humidity exceeds 90%. Don't try using one in the steam room.

Do you need anything to go with it?

All you need is a hose to connect it to your torch.

How noisy is a generator?

The small machines are whisper quiet. The large machines are about as noisy as your washing machine.
